**CORRECTIVE AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION
FOR CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT OF SECTION 214 AUTHORIZATION
FROM VERISIGN, INC. TO GLOBALTEL LD, INC., FILE NO. ITC-T/C-2006-01934**

This application, tendered for filing July 24, 2006 is hereby amended as follows:

National Telemanagement Corporation d/b/a American Roaming Network was merged into Illuminet, Inc. on December 28, 2004. On December 31, 2004, Illuminet was merged into VeriSign, Inc. pursuant to Commission consent (File No. ITC-ASG-200502125-00180, granted May 11, 2005). Accordingly, the instant application should be reclassified as an assignment of Section 214 authorization from VeriSign, Inc. to GlobalTel LD, Inc. rather than a transfer of control of Section 214 authorization held by National Telemanagement Corporation d/b/a American Roaming Network from VeriSign to GlobalTel.

Applicant's response to Question No. 13 is revised as follows:

On July 30, 2006, VeriSign, Inc. and GlobalTel LD, Inc. executed an asset purchase agreement. Pursuant to that agreement, GlobalTel will acquire the assets of VeriSign which previously were held by National Telemanagement Corporation prior to its merger into Illuminet and subsequent merger of Illuminet into VeriSign. These assets include the d/b/a's used by VeriSign, including the d/b/a American Roaming Network, in all jurisdictions in which VeriSign operates American Roaming Network, as well as the customer base of American Roaming Network. Upon grant of this application, the parties will consummate the purchase by GlobalTel LD of those assets. GlobalTel will continue to provide the services currently provided by VeriSign under the name American Roaming Network. Pursuant to the Commission's rules, the parties will notify the Commission that the transaction has been consummated.
