ANSWER TO QUESTION 11

The assignee, SkyPort Global Communications, Inc. (“SkyPort Global”), a Texas corporation, is 66.5% owned by Bankton Financial Corporation, LLC, a Texas limited liability corporation, which in turn is 100% owned by Bankton Financial Corporation (“Bankton-Canada”), a Canadian corporation. All of the Bankton-Canada shares are held in an irrevocable Canadian trust; Mr. Robert Kubbernus, a trustee and SkyPort Global’s pre-existing controlling shareholder, votes all of the Bankton-Canada shares on the trust’s behalf. Accordingly, by virtue of Bankton-Canada’s 100% ownership of Bankton-Texas, and Bankton-Texas’ 66.5% interest in SkyPort Global, Mr. Kubbernus, a Canadian citizen, will remain SkyPort Global’s controlling stockholder.

ANSWER TO QUESTION 13

SkyPort Global is filing this notification to advise the Commission that it has effectuated its Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization. The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division approved the Plan by written order dated August 12, 2009 (Case No. 08-36737-H4). As a result, SkyPort must effectuate a *pro forma* assignment of its Section 214 authorization from SkyPort Global Communications, Inc., Debtor-in-Possession, to SkyPort Global.
