Greetings.

Following up on your question to me yesterday on the Affinity Application (File No. ITC-ASG-20100524-00213), the answers to your two questions are:

- 1) Affinity Section 214: As we discussed, we understand that Affinity is now a defunct company – so there is no one left at that entity to call. However, we believe that Affinity's international Section 214 authority can be found in File No. ITC-214-20020416-00186 (the address and other information associated with that file number seem to correspond to the information we have for Affinity).
- 2) Nature of Assignment: In terms of whether the assignment was partial or complete, Liberty-Bell Telecom acquired all of the customers of Affinity but did not acquire all of the operations of Affinity. In particular, Affinity retained all of its equipment, operating licenses (including its Section 214) and various other property.
