Dear Ms. Dortch:

The parties submit this supplement to the above-referenced application for the partial assignment of International Section 214 authorization File No. ITC-214-20100326-00126 from Youghioghenny Communications – Texas, LLC (“YCT”) to STX Wireless, LLC (“STX”). The parties have agreed to assign YCT’s customers in the Corpus Christi, Texas market in addition to the customers in the other markets specified in the application. Thus, the parties now seek Commission consent to the assignment of all customers and the international Section 214 authority associated therewith to STX. While YCT will no longer provide international service to these customers, YCT will still retain a portion of the international Section 214 authorization to allow it to provide international resold services after the close of the proposed transaction should its business plans change at a later date.

No substantive change to the application is proposed by this supplement, and thus, the parties request continued processing under streamlined procedures pursuant to Section 63.12(c)(1)(ii) of the Commission’s rules.
