IP Network America LLC's application for authority to provide facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 100% owned by a citizen of **Mexico**.

ITC-214-20130226-00053 (e-file)

Procom Inc.'s application for authority to provide facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Two citizens of **Mexico** each of whom owns 50% of the applicant.

ITC-214-20130221-00063 (e-file)

Speed Telco LLC's application for authority to provide resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 80% owned by a citizen of **Somalia**.

ITC-ASG-20130228-00067 (e-file)
