<u>APPLICATION</u>

Florida Prepaid Cellular, LLC ("FPC" or "Applicant"), and Spot Mobile Corporation ("Spot Mobile"), hereby jointly request authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214 (1982) and Section 63.24, of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.24, to transfer substantially all of the assets of Spot Mobile to FPC (the "Application"). Further, in connection with this transfer, FPC requests a grant of global resale Section 214 authority. Spot Mobile provides mobile communications to retail customers throughout the United States. FPC is a U.S. company organized to provide mobile telecommunications services, and has no foreign affiliations.

Pursuant to the contemplated transaction, FCP will acquire approximately 120,000 prepaid customers, currently receiving international service from Spot Mobile, as well as certain authorization currently held by Spot Mobile is not being transferred to FPC. Spot Mobile will retain its 214 license. FPC does not currently have a 214 authorization and respectfully requests a 214 authorization as part of this application. FPC will provide service to the transferred customers under the Spot brand. There will be no interruption in service whatsoever and, thus, the transaction will be seamless from the customers' perspective. By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by ensuring that customers of Spot Mobile continue to receive mobile communications services with excellent support and competitive rate plans.

 private lines to a country for which the Commission has not previously
 authorized the provision of switched services over private lines; and
- 4. The Commission has not informed FPC in writing that this Application is not eligible for streamlined processing.

In conclusion, FPC and Spot Mobile certify that all of the information in this Application is accurate and correct. For these reasons, FPC and Spot Mobile respectfully request that the Commission grant this Application.


