INTRODUCTION

On December 31, 2003, a corporate reorganization occurred, resulting in the change of the authorization holder's entity format from a Texas corporation into a Texas limited partnership, "Santa Rosa Communications, Ltd.," with no change in ultimate ownership or control. Unfortunately, inadvertent oversight resulted in the late filing of a notification of a *pro forma* assignment of the license pursuant to Section 63.24(f) of the Commission's Rules. The instant notification of the *pro forma* change in ownership structure is submitted to ensure that the record is correct and complete.

Answer to Question 11, providing ownership information pursuant to Section 63.18(h):

Santa Rosa Communications, Ltd. (FRN 0004278438) ("SRCL"), is a Texas

limited partnership. It is the successor in interest to Santa Rosa Communications, Inc., a

Texas corporation, which was reorganized pursuant to Texas law for business purposes. The former corporation was a wholly-owned subsidiary of Santa Rosa Telephone Cooperative, Inc., a Texas cooperative corporation. Ultimate ownership of the former corporation and the current partnership are identical.

SRCL's single general partner, Santa Rosa Investments, Inc. ("SRI") is a Texas corporation, owning 1% of the equity interest in PLTL. The remaining 99% equity ownership interest is held by SRCL's single limited partner, Santa Rosa Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (the "Cooperative"), a Texas corporation. The Cooperative also owns 100% of SRI. The Cooperative is owned by its member/subscribers; no single member/subscriber owns or controls more than 5% of the Cooperative's equity. Response to Question 13: As noted above, the assets of Santa Rosa Communications, Inc. were assigned to Santa Rosa Communications, Ltd. in the context of a corporate reorganization.
