
ARX Communications, LLC ("ARX" or "Assignor") and PBH Communications Services, LLC, ("PBH" or "Assignee") (collectively "Applicants"), by undersigned counsel, hereby file this letter to respond to questions of the International Bureau staff regarding the above-referenced Application.

The Applicants confirm that the response to Question 11 in Attachment A contains a typo and should read: "The following entity owns or controls 10% or more of Assignee . . ." As a result of this change, the ownership information contained in the Response to Question 11 pertains to Assignee, not Assignor. Additionally, the Applicants confirm that Assignor is organized in Delaware and Assignee is organized in Colorado.

The Applicants confirm that Mr. Abdul Mohaymen Sahebzadah and Mr. Paul van Loon, the owners of Assignee, do not hold negative control of or controlling interest in Assignee. Upon closing of the proposed Transaction, Assignee will provide services to existing customers of Assignor that currently receive services under Assignor's International 214 authorization. Further, after closing the transaction, Assignor will continue to operate, but will no longer provide international communications services.
