## Supplement to the Application of Slappey Telephone, Inc. and Slappey Communications, LLC ITC-ASG-20190612-00120

The following is a supplement to the Joint Application for Consent to Transfer Domestic and International Section 214 Authority from Slappey Telephone, Inc., an Alabama corporation, as transferor ("Slappey Telephone"), to Slappey Communications, LLC, a Texas limited liability company, as transferee ("Slappey Communications"). Slappey Communications is a newly formed limited liability company that was formed to effectuate the transaction described in section 8 below. - 2. Slappey Communications does not currently provide international services and does not hold a section 214 international authorization. Slappey Communications intends to offer international services to its customers upon the approval of the assignment of the required licenses from Slappey Telephone to Slappey Communications.
- 3. Slappey Communications and Slappey Telephone intend for Slappey Telephone to assign its 214 authorization to Slappey Communications.

- 8. Pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement dated May 30, 2019, Slappey Communications purchased from Slappey Telephone substantially all of the assets of Slappey Telephone. In order to ensure an orderly transition of Slappey Telephone's licenses and any assets that relate to Slappey Telephone's operation or engagement in transmission of telecommunication services, the parties entered into a Transition Services Agreement dated May 30, 2019, whereby all licenses held by Telephone and assets related to the transmission of telecommunication services and regulated by the Federal Communications Commission were excluded from the transaction. Slappey Telephone is still providing the applicable services and assets until the Commission's approval of the transfer of the 214 authorization.
- 9. None of the entities or persons involved in this joint application have a 10% or greater interest in any domestic telecommunications provider.
