

## ATTACHMENT 1

### Responses to Questions 10 and 13

Assignee Farmers Independent Telephone Company (“Farmers”), a Wisconsin corporation, is a rural independent local exchange carrier that provides a range of telecommunications and information services including voice and broadband services. As of the end of 2020, Farmers was owned by 361 shareholders, none of whom directly or indirectly own or control ten percent (10%) or more of the company’s equity or voting power. Whereas the specific number of shareholders fluctuates slightly over time due to matters such as family and estate distributions and households moving into and out of the Farmers service area, the widely-held distribution of Farmers stock is expected to continue during the foreseeable future.

Farmers has long owned 100 percent of the stock of Grantsburg Telecom, Inc. (“Grantsburg”), a Wisconsin corporation, that holds the subject International Section 214 Authorization for Global Resale (File No. ITC-214-19971029-00669) and that has been providing, *inter alia*, resold international toll services.

As of January 1, 2021, Farmers merged its wholly-owned subsidiary Grantsburg into itself as part of a *pro forma* internal corporate reorganization. As a result, Farmers will now hold the subject International Section 214 Authorization and will provide the subject resold international toll services directly under its own name or a trade name.
