Notification of Partial *Pro Forma* Assignment

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, (“the Act”), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.24(f) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.24(f), the Commission is hereby notified of the *pro forma* assignment of partial Section 214 authority from SprintCom, Inc. (“SprintCom”) to T-Mobile Puerto Rico LLC (“T-Mobile PR”). The transaction, which occurred on December 30, 2021, involved the assignment of the Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands (USVI) customer bases of SprintCom to T-Mobile PR. Both the assignor and assignee are indirect wholly owned subsidiaries of T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) and thus ultimate control of the Section 214 authority being assigned has not changed.

KfW which, as described above, holds approximately 17 percent of the ownership interests in DT. Thus, FRG is deemed to hold approximately 32 percent of DT.

No other individual or entity will hold directly or indirectly a ten percent or greater equity and/or voting interest in T-Mobile PR.

Answer to Question 13:

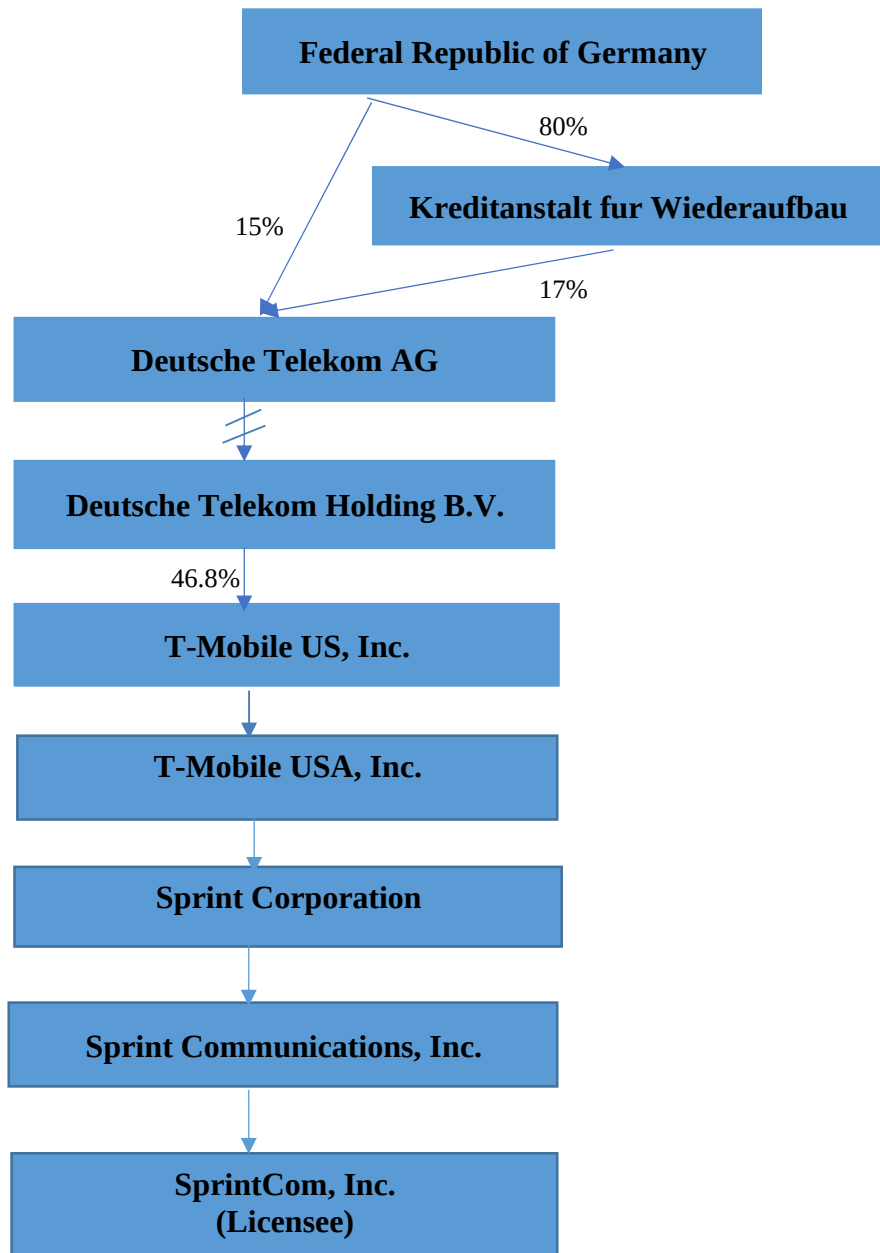
The Commission is hereby notified of the *pro forma* assignment of partial Section 214 authority held by SprintCom to T-Mobile PR. The purpose of the transaction is to consolidate T-Mobile's Puerto Rico and USVI assets, customers and FCC licenses in T-Mobile PR. The transaction occurred on December 30, 2021, and involved no change in the ownership of any entity. Attached are charts showing the ownership of the Assignor and Assignee before and after the transaction.

Because the restructuring did not change the ultimate control of the Section 214 authority, the transaction was *pro forma* in nature.¹ The Commission has stated that, in situations “where no substantial change of control will result from the transfer or assignment, grant of the application is deemed presumptively in the public interest.”²

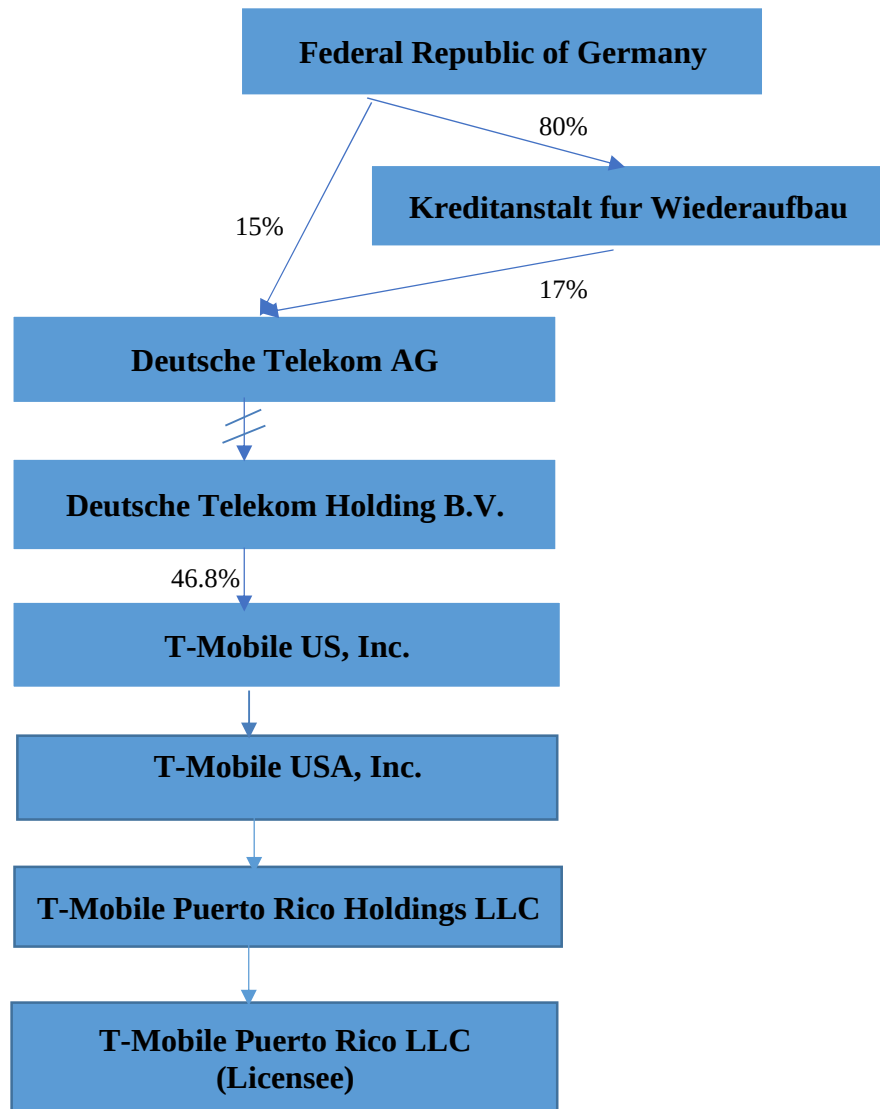
