Responses to Questions 10 and 13

Through a *pro forma* internal corporate reorganization and subsequent corporate name change – neither of which entailed any change of ultimate ownership or control – New Ulm Long Distance, Inc. (the original holder of the subject International Section 214 Authorization for Global Resale under File Number ITC-214-19970402-00192, granted May 22, 1997) has become Nuvera Communications, Inc.

New Ulm Long Distance, Inc. was formed in 1997 as a wholly-owned subsidiary of New Ulm Telecom, Inc. for the purposes of reselling domestic and international long distance toll services. New Ulm Long Distance, Inc. applied for and received the subject International Section 214 Authorization for Global Resale during the Spring of 1997.

During 2015, New Ulm Telecom, Inc. completed a *pro forma* internal corporate reorganization in which it rolled New Ulm Long Distance, Inc. up into itself as the parent and surviving consolidated entity. The corporate reorganization entailed no change in the ownership of the parent New Ulm Telecom, Inc. nor in the ultimate ownership of the former subsidiary New Ulm Long Distance, Inc.

In May 2018, New Ulm Telecom, Inc. changed its name to Nuvera Communications, Inc. This was a straightforward name change, and involved no change in ownership or control of the entity.

Hence, by the foregoing series of *pro forma* changes, the holder of the subject International Section 214 Authorization for Global Resale (File Number ITC-214-19970402-00192, granted May 22, 1997) has become Nuvera Communications, Inc.
