APPLICATION

PIPELINE TELECOM, INCORPORATED (“PIPELINE” or “Applicant”), hereby requests modification of authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission”) Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, to provide Inmarsat and Mobile Satellite Service between the United States and International points, except those international points not authorized by the Commission (the “Application”).

PIPELINE is a U.S. company organized to provide international telecommunications services. PIPELINE has no foreign affiliations. By granting this application for modification, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of the modification of Section 214 authority to PIPELINE.

This license grants PIPELINE authority to provide International facilities-based and resold services to all international points pursuant to Sections 63.18(e)(1) and (e)(2).
- (e) PIPELINE requests Inmarsat and Mobile Satellite Section 214 authority pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(3).
- (f) At this time, PIPELINE seeks no other authorization available under Section 63.18(e).

PIPELINE certifies that:

3. It does not seek authority to provide switched basic services over private lines to a country for which the Commission has not previously authorized the provision of switched service over private lines; and
4. The Commission has not informed PIPELINE in writing that this Application is not eligible for streamline processing.
