Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Taino-Carib Consortium further amends and supplements the above-referenced Cable Landing License Application filed on June 29, 2018 (“Cable Landing License Application”) and Application for Modification of Section 214 Authority filed on October 25, 2019 (“Section 214 Modification Application”) as follows.

**1. Cable Landing License Application, Appendix E & Section 214 Modification Application, Appendix C – Prepa Networks, LLC**

On October 30, 2020, Prepa Networks, LLC changed its name to Hub Advanced Networks, LLC. All other information concerning this Applicant remains unchanged.

**2. Cable Landing License Application, Appendix D – Isla Verde Cable Landing Station**

The information regarding the Isla Verde, Puerto Rico Cable Landing Station provided in Appendix D, Tab 2 of the Cable Landing License Application remains correct. All traffic on the cable originating and terminating at Isla Verde continues to originate and terminate at the current landing station (but passes through the new landing station), with the exception of traffic on one fiber pair added to the cable as the result of a 2018 upgrade which originates and terminates at the new landing station. At a later time, all traffic originating and terminating at Isla Verde will originate and terminate at the new landing station.


**3. Other Information**

With the exception of the name change by Prepa Networks, LLC described above, the information concerning ownership shares and voting interests of the Applicants for the Cable Landing License provided in our letter dated August 4, 2020 remains correct.

We also note that Global Interlink Ltd., which is a non-Applicant member of the Taino-Carib Consortium, has transferred its ownership interest to its parent company, Altice Dominicana, S.A. There are no other changes in the information provided in our letter dated August 4, 2020.


