

Conditions for Grant of Katrina-related STA request

FTMSC's Sept. 6, 2005 request for special temporary authority (STA) IS GRANTED. Accordingly, FTMSC is authorized from Sept. 1, 2005 to Oct 1, 2005 to provide Inmarsat mobile satellite services using up to 2000 M-4 and 2000 Mini-M Inmarsat terminals in the areas affected by Hurricane Katrina

on an unprotected non-interference basis in accordance with the terms, conditions, and technical specifications set forth in the Commission's rules and this document.

1. FTMSC shall coordinate all of its operations so that no harmful interference shall be caused to any other lawfully operating satellites or radiocommunication system.

FTMSC shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and inform the Commission in writing immediately of such an event.

2. FTMSC is required to accept interference from other lawfully operating satellites or radiocommunication systems.

3. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special authority is solely at FTMSC's own risk.
