On October 6, 2006, FTMSC US, LLC (FTMSC) requests a new Special Temporary Authority (STA) for 60 days, commencing from October 17, 2006, to provide Inmarsat's Broad Global Area Network (BGAN) services due to a proposed transfer of control of FTMSC to MobSat S.A.S. (MobSat). France Telecom and MobSat are ready to consummate the proposed transaction on October 31, 2006.

FTMSC is currently providing BGAN services in the United States pursuant to STA: ITC-STA-20060314-00158 and SES-STA-20060314-00438.

Pursuant your request of September 12, 2006, the underlying applications (ITC-AMMD-20060804-00388, SES-AMMD-20060804-01315 and ITC-PDR-20060804-00010) have been removed from streamlined processing and pending under your review.

FTMSC understands that grant of new STAs will be without prejudice to Commission's action on the underlying applications, and agrees to operate subject to the conditions in its original BGAN STAs.

Please review the new STA applications and advise us whether they raise any national security, law enforcement, foreign policy or trade concerns. The Commission may want to act expeditiously on these applications. We therefore request your advice by **C.O.B. October 16, 2006**.
