Re: ITC-STA-20080829-00413 (Clarus Digicom, LLC - Clarus Digicom, Inc.)

To Whom It May Concern:

We hereby request for special temporary authority to continue providing service to customers while the Commission processes the underlying assignment application for the international section 214 authority based on Section 63.25 of the Commission's rules on special provisions relating to temporary or emergency service by international carriers.

Our request for the STA is to transfer control of Clarus Digicom, LLC and its Section 214 certificate to Clarus Digicom, Inc. We failed to initially notify the FCC of the change from a LLC to a corporation and the change of percentage of ownership. We sincerely apologize for the lack of procedural knowledge, as we thought that no reporting was necessary as long as all shareholders are US citizens and the company is 100% American. We have since incorporated in our administrative procedure to file a request to FCC before any substantial change of control can take effect within our company structure.

By granting the STA will enable us to avoid a discontinuance of service to customers while the Commission considers whether the public interest would be served by granting the application. We are currently serving over 5,000 customers who rely on our services to frequently call friends and family in Vietnam as well as businesses that contribute to the 6.5 billion annual US-Vietnam bilateral trade.

"The parties acknowledge that the grant of this STA will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the underlying application seeking Commission consent to the transfer/assignment. The parties further acknowledge that this STA can be revoked by the Commission upon its own motion without a hearing."

The duration of the STA request is for six months or until the Commission renders its decision to grant the transfer/assignment.
