**INTERNATIONAL SECTION 214 REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF SPECIAL
TEMPORARY AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE INMARSAT BGAN SERVICE**

VIZADA Services LLC ("VIZADA") hereby requests special temporary authority ("STA") to continue to provide Inmarsat BGAN services via the Inmarsat 4F2 satellite at 52.75° W.L. from December 24, 2009 through January 6, 2009. In addition, Vizada requests STA for a period of 60 days, commencing January 7, 2009, to provide Inmarsat BGAN services via the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite at 97.65° W.L.

Grant of the requested extension and new STA will serve the public interest by permitting VIZADA to provide continuity of service to customers as BGAN services transition from the 4F2 satellite to the 4F3 satellite.

In October 2005, VIZADA (under its former name, FTMSC US, LLC) filed applications seeking international Section 214 authority and an earth station blanket license to operate up to 20,000 terminals communicating with Inmarsat's next-generation spacecraft to provide BGAN services. See File Nos. ITC-214-20051012-00406 & ITC-AMD-20060804-00388 and SES-LFS-20051011-01396; SES-AMD-20051118-01602; SES-AMD-20060605-00926; & SES-AMD-20060804-01315, Call Sign E050284. VIZADA subsequently filed requests for special temporary authority to allow it to commence offering service while the underlying applications were being processed. The initial STA requests were granted May 12, 2006. See File Nos. SES-STA-20060314-00438 and ITC-STA-20060314-00158.

In order to provide service continuity, VIZADA has requested extension of its STAs every 60 days, most recently in File Nos. SES-STA-20081016-01333 and ITC-STA-20081016-00465.

On January 7, 2009, Inmarsat's BGAN service will be relocated from the 4F2 satellite currently located at 52.75° W.L. to the 4F3 satellite at 97.65° W.L. By this application, VIZADA seeks authority to provide Inmarsat BGAN services via the Inmarsat 4F2 satellite at 52.75° W.L. from December 24, 2009 through January 6, 2009 and to provide Inmarsat BGAN services via the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite at 97.65° W.L. commencing January 7, 2009 for a period of 60 days.

In support of this request, VIZADA hereby incorporates by reference the information provided in its applications for regular BGAN service authority as amended, its prior STA requests, and its pleadings in those proceedings. VIZADA agrees to continue to operate subject to the terms and conditions contained in the original STA grant issued on May 12, 2006.
