As CEO of Five9, I, Michael Burkland certify under the standards listed on the STA Application, 18 U.S.C. § 1001, 47 U.S.C. § 312(a)(1), 47 U.S.C. § 503, that Five9 supplements its STA Application by agreeing to the following three (3) provisions:
