Hi George,

The Team Telecom agencies have discussed the issue of the pending STA extension in 13-55, and the fact that the applicant has failed to respond to our November 26, 2013 supplemental questions in 13-54 and 13-56. At this point, given that the applicant's counsel has promised that the substantive-question responses will be provided by COB on March 5, 2014 in Team Telecom cases 13-54 and 13-56, Team Telecom does not object to the requested extension of the STA in 13-55. I note that if the applicant fails to respond by the March 5th date, I expect that Team Telecom will quickly move to recommend that the FCC dismiss the pending applications.
