Dear Ms. Dortch,

Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 214, SelecTel, Inc. (FRN 00184988352) (“SelecTel” or the “Transferor”) along with Compass Atlantic Inc. and Compass Capital Incorporated (collectively “Transferee”) (Transferor and Transferee together the “Parties”), hereby request an extension of the international Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) originally granted by the Commission on May 29, 2015, to allow SelecTel to continue to provide service to its end user customers pending Commission approval of their joint section 214 applications for domestic and international transfer of control (“Joint Application”).

Background

A combined Joint Application for approval of the transfer of control was filed on December 12, 2014; however, the international application was withdrawn at SelecTel’s request and the domestic application is currently pending before the Commission. A revised section 214 international application has been filed on MyIBFS, Submission ID IB2015000960 (ITC-T/C-20150521-00129).

SelecTel, Inc. provides resold local and long-distance voice telephone services in the states of Massachusetts, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, Oregon, Pennsylvania, and Washington. SelecTel also provides resold wireless services throughout the United States.

On May 21, 2015, SelecTel filed its original request for Special Temporary Authority for SelecTel to consummate a pending transaction prior to the final FCC approval in order to allow SelecTel to continue to provide service to its end user customers pending Commission approval of their section 214 applications for domestic and international transfer of control. The Company was granted an international STA on May 29, 2015, which expires on November 25, 2015.

On June 19, 2015, the Parties consummated the transfer of control as disconnection of SelecTel's customers was imminent if SelecTel did not receive funding. Compass Capital Incorporated formed a new Delaware corporation, Compass Atlantic Inc., to acquire a majority of the stock of SelecTel. Pre-transaction, SelecTel had three shareholders: Teri O'Flaherty, Matthew O'Flaherty, and Stacy Hergenrader, each holding 33.33% of the stock of SelecTel. Compass Atlantic Inc. acquired all the stock of Teri O'Flaherty and Stacy Hergenrader, such that after the transaction, Compass Atlantic Inc. holds 66.67% of the stock and Matthew O'Flaherty owns 33.33% of the stock. SelecTel remains the certificated entity.

Based on the transfer of majority control to Transferee, the Parties filed the Transfer of Control Applications and the STA requests (which were promptly granted by Commission staff) to comply fully with the Commission's Rules. The Commission granted an extension of the Parties' domestic STA on September 10, 2015, valid for sixty (60) days, and SelecTel filed a joint request for renewed extension of domestic STA on November 5, 2015. The Parties now seek an extension of the existing international STA.

Request for Extension of International STA; Good Cause

SelecTel and its owners hereby respectfully request an extension of the international STA to allow SelecTel to continue to serve its customers without interruption pending Commission approval of the Joint Application. The Parties submit that good cause exists for extending the international STA on the basis that additional time is needed because the underlying Transfer of Control applications were removed from streamlined treatment by the Commission while the Executive Branch Agencies, participating in a working group informally known as "Team Telecom" (Department of Homeland Security, Department of Justice, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the Department of Defense), review the Transfer of Control Applications. That review remains ongoing and provides ample grounds for a grant of an extension at this time.

Conclusion

Grant of the instant international STA extension request will serve the public interest as such grant will ensure no interruption of service, no inconvenience to customers, and no diminution in the availability of competitive local services. The transfer of control transaction was transparent and did not result in a reduction or impairment of service to SelecTel's customers. As a result of the transfer of control, SelecTel continues to have the technical, financial, and managerial capabilities to ensure the continuing provision of quality service to its customers.

SelecTel, Inc., Compass Atlantic Inc., and Compass Capital Incorporated further acknowledge that grant of an extension for SelecTel's international STA and grant of the Joint Application will not preclude enforcement action.



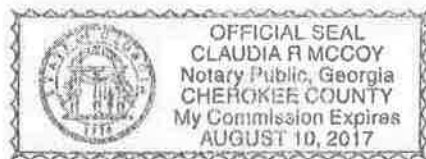
