

Justification for Request for Special Temporary Authority

Xtel Communications, Inc. (“Xtel” or “Company”), pursuant to Section 63.25 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.25, hereby respectfully requests Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to provide international resold telecommunications service pending the Commission’s consideration and final action on the Application for International Global or Limited Global Resale Authority submitted by Xtel contemporaneous with this STA request (see Submission ID IB2022003189)

This STA is requested to allow Xtel to continue to provide resold international message toll services to customers while its international 214 license application is pending. An STA to authorize temporary authority would be in the public interest in that it will avoid disruption of service to the carrier’s public subscribers. Xtel’s management recently became aware that it has been providing resold international message toll services to its customers without authorization, as required by the Commission’s rules. This was not an intentional violation. Xtel’s management believed that it had such authority. However, while in the process of preparing a 214 application for the assignment of assets associated with a potential asset purchase that Xtel is negotiating, its management became aware that it did not have Section 214 authorization to provide resold international service. Accordingly, Xtel is now taking the appropriate action to correct this oversight by submitting a Section 214 application for authorization to provide resold international telecommunications services and applying for this Special Temporary Authority while the Section 214 application is pending.

The Company acknowledges that grant of the STA will not prejudice action by the Commission on the underlying international 214 application and that the STA is subject to cancellation or modification upon notice without a hearing.

Length of STA Request

The STA is requested for a period of 180 days, or until such time as the Commission has taken dispositive action on the concurrent Section 214 application.
