

Justification of Need for Special Temporary Authority – Cloaked Wireless Inc.

The following is our justification for the need of special temporary authority to conduct business while our 214 application is pending. Our initial application was recommended for dismissal after 5 months and several triage responses *without prejudice* due to a misunderstanding (and for which we provided and well-reasoned request for reconsideration). Since that application, Jonathan Wilkins has resigned from Cloaked Wireless and now works for the parent company. Jonathan Wilkins will not be involved in the day-to-day operations of Cloaked Wireless and instead will be heading up and working on a different product line of the parent company. Jonathan Wilkins will also be divesting his ownership in the company until such time as the allegations in California have been resolved and the FCC approves of the repossession of his ownership in the parent company (Cloaked Services Inc). Jonathan Wilkins has done all these things voluntarily in order to remove any impact his personal affairs could have on the future success of the company. Due to operational costs related to the drawn out prior application and remaining ready (but unable to operate), additional delays increase the potential financial risk and will require Cloaked Services to seek additional financing while we wait for the FCC to respond. Since initially applying it's been nine months. Additional delays could further negatively impact the business. The totality of the circumstances demand and require for justice to be done that the approval of the temporary authority for Cloaked Wireless to conduct business be granted.
