Joint Application

Pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, uniView Technologies Advanced Systems Group, Inc. ("uniView") and Zirca Corporation ("Zirca") hereby jointly request Commission authority to acquire, by assignment, Zirca's Section 214 authorization to operate as a global facilities-based and resale carrier. The file number under which the initial authorization was granted to Zirca is ITC-214-19980827-00599. The means through which the assignment will take place is the sale and transfer of Zirca assets to uniView, and the assignment to, and assumption of, liabilities by uniView of existing Zirca contracts. uniView is a U.S. company which provides international telecommunications services. Granting of this joint application would promote competition in the international services

market. Such competition would benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest would be served by the grant of this joint application.


Conclusion
