**APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO TRANSFER OF CONTROL
OF STREAMLINED INTERNATIONAL SECTION 214 AUTHORIZATION**

ST Long Distance, Inc. ("STLDD"), MJD Communications, Inc. ("MJD"), and Thomas H. Lee Equity Fund IV, L.P. ("THE"), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, respectfully request Commission consent to the proposed transfer of control of STLDD and its existing Streamlined International Section 214 Authorization, as well as STLDD's ultimate parent company MJD, from the existing common stockholders of MJD to THE.

Introduction

STLDD resells switched international telecommunications services pursuant to a streamlined International Section 214 Authorization granted by the Commission under File No. ITC-96-620 (now ITC-214-19961118-00578), granted January 8, 1997, and under subsequent transfers of control authorized under File No. ITC-97-284-TC, granted July 14, 1997, and under File No. ITC-98-194-TC, granted March 19, 1998.

STLD, a Delaware corporation, is a wholly-owned subsidiary of ST Enterprises, Ltd.

(“STE”), also a Delaware corporation. In turn, STE is a wholly-owned subsidiary of MJD.

THL and related funds presently own non-voting, preferred stock comprising a 43.3 percent equity interest in MJD. Upon receipt of Commission approval of this application and applications for transfer of control of other Commission authorizations, THL and related funds will convert their preferred stock into common stock comprising a 47.2 percent voting interest in MJD. At that point, THL will be MJD’s largest stockholder and its principal source of future additional equity funding. In other words, THL will obtain and exercise de facto control of MJD and its subsidiaries, including STLD, at the time of conversion and for the foreseeable future thereafter. It is likely that THL’s common stock interest in MJD will grow to exceed the 50.0 percent de jure control boundary at some point during the next year or two.

The proposed transfer of control of MJD and its subsidiaries, including STLD, to THL will serve the public interest by allowing STLD to draw upon the financial and administrative resources of THL and MJD as it continues to resell and market its international telecommunications services in highly competitive markets.

Grant of this application will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity and in support thereof, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the

Commission’s Rules:

STLD: (1) will continue to maintain separate books of account from affiliated local exchange carriers; (2) will continue not to jointly own transmission or switching facilities with affiliated local exchange carriers; and (3) will continue to take any tariffed services from affiliated local exchange carriers pursuant to the terms and conditions of their generally applicable tariffs.

STLD will continue to be treated as a nonregulated affiliate for purposes of local exchange carrier accounting under the Commission's joint cost and affiliate transactions rules as set forth in Parts 32 and 64 of the Commission's Rules.

Foreign Concessions and Arrangements

STLD, MJD and THL each certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions, directly or indirectly, from any foreign carrier or foreign administration with respect to traffic and revenue flows between the United States and any foreign country which STLD may serve under the authority sought; and that it will not enter into such agreements in the future.

Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification

STLD, MJD and THL each certifies that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, no party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. 862.

CONCLUSION

In light of the foregoing, STLD, MJD and THL respectfully submit that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be served by a grant of the proposed transfer of control of STLD and its International Section 214 Authorization from the current stockholders of MJD to THL.


