

AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF CONTROL

Pursuant to Section 63.50 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission, 47

C.F.R. § 63.50, Teleglobe USA Inc., Teleglobe Business Solutions Inc., Excel

Telecommunications, Inc., Long Distance Wholesale Club, Inc., and Telecom Vision

International Inc. (collectively, the “Teleglobe Applicants”) submit this Amendment to their
currently pending Application filed in the above-captioned proceeding on March 30, 2000.

Specifically, the Teleglobe Applicants hereby amend their Application to clarify that Excel
Telecommunications, Inc. holds the relevant Section 214 authorizations, rather than Excel
Communications, Inc. Although Exhibit B of the original Application correctly specifies
Excel Telecommunications, Inc. as the holder of certain Section 214 authorizations, other
portions of the Application erroneously suggest that Excel Communications, Inc. holds such
Section 214 authorizations. Accordingly, all references in the original Application to “Excel

Communications, Inc.” should be deleted and replaced with “Excel Telecommunications, Inc.”
