Following consummation of the proposed transfer, Ms. Laguna will own 100 percent of e-traffic.com. Approval of the proposed transfer will permit a reorganized e-traffic.com to offer its high quality, low cost telecommunications services more efficiently, thus enabling the company to compete more effectively in the international telecommunications marketplace. Accordingly, grant of the instant application will serve the public interest.

In support of this application, Mr. Puig and Ms. Laguna submit the following information:

I. THE PROPOSED TRANSACTION

In the proposed transaction, Ms. Laguna will purchase all of the voting common stock of e-traffic.com held by Mr. Puig, pursuant to a Stock Purchase Agreement entered into by both parties. Following Commission approval of the instant transfer application and consummation of the transaction, Ms. Laguna will become the sole owner of e-traffic.com. The proposed transaction will not disrupt service or cause inconvenience or confusion for e-traffic.com's customers.

II. PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS

Consummation of the proposed transaction will result in a reorganized e-traffic.com under the sole control of Ms. Laguna. The organizational efficiencies that will flow from this transaction will enhance the ability of e-traffic.com to offer high quality, low cost telecommunications services to the public. These efficiencies will also serve the public interest by promoting vigorous competition among international carriers.

Neither Mr. Puig nor Ms. Laguna holds nor has held previously any authorization pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. e-traffic.com holds a Section 214 authorization to provide global facilities-based and resale services.

e-traffic.com has no interlocking directorates with any foreign carrier.

(i) The transferee, Ms. Laguna, certifies that neither she nor e-traffic.com has an affiliation with any foreign carrier, as that term is defined in Section 63.09 of the Commission's rules.

(j) Ms. Laguna certifies, pursuant to Section 63.18(j) of the Commission's rules, that neither she nor e-traffic.com seeks to provide international telecommunications services to any destination country in which: (1) e-traffic.com is a foreign carrier in that country; (2) e-traffic.com controls a foreign carrier in that country; or (3) any entity that owns more than 25 percent of e-traffic.com, or that controls e-traffic.com, controls a foreign carrier in that country. Ms. Laguna also hereby certifies that neither she nor e-traffic.com seeks to provide international telecommunications services to any destination country in which two or more foreign carriers (or parties that control foreign carriers) own, in the aggregate, more than 25 percent of e-traffic.com and are parties to, or the beneficiaries of, a contractual relation affecting the provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.

(n) As required by Section 63.18(n) of the Commission's rules, Ms. Laguna hereby certifies that neither she nor e-traffic.com has agreed to accept special concessions, as defined by the Commission's rules, directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses market power on the foreign end of the route. In addition, Ms. Laguna hereby certifies that neither she nor e-traffic.com will enter into such agreements in the future.

(o) A certification pursuant to Sections 1.2001 through 1.2003 of the Commission's rules is attached hereto.

(p) The instant application qualifies for streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules, in that e-traffic.com has no affiliation with any foreign carrier or any dominant U.S. carrier, and does not seek authority herein to provide switched basic services over private lines to any country for which the Commission has not yet authorized such service.

CONCLUSION






