**APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF SECTION 214 AUTHORITY**

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §

214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.18, Tritel Communications,

Inc. ("Tritel") and TeleCorp PCS Inc. ("TPP") (collectively "Applicants")<sup>1</sup> hereby request

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<sup>1</sup> This application is being filed on behalf of Tritel Communications, Inc. and a newly created merger entity that will assume the name TeleCorp PCS, Inc after the currently existing TeleCorp PCS, Inc. is renamed TeleCorp Wireless, Inc. This will occur immediately prior to the acquisition by merger of Tritel, Inc. (the ultimate corporate parent of Tritel Communications, Inc.) and Indus, Inc. The currently existing TeleCorp PCS, Inc. is the parent entity of the TeleCorp family of companies. It will be renamed immediately prior to this merger to allow the ultimate post-merger parent entity to assume the name TeleCorp PCS, Inc. For ease of reference herein, the newly created merger entity will be referred to as "TeleCorp PCS, Inc." or "TPP," and the renamed old TeleCorp PCS, Inc. will be referred to as "TeleCorp Wireless, Inc." or "TWI." Commission consent to the transfer of any authorization to provide global or limited global resale service between the United States and all international points which Tritel may receive pursuant to its Section 214 application filed with the Commission on October 13, 2000.<sup>2</sup>

As the Commission is aware, currently pending before the FCC is an application that requests, among other things, that the FCC authorize the transfer of control of Tritel, Inc. and its direct and indirect subsidiaries (including Tritel) to TPI. This will be accomplished in two conceptual phases. In the first conceptual phase of the transaction, TPI will engage in a one-for-one stock swap with TWI, rendering TWI a wholly-owned subsidiary of TPI. In the second conceptual phase of the transaction, TPI simultaneously will engage in a stock swap with Tritel, Inc. in which each Tritel shareholder will receive 0.76 shares of the post-merger TPI stock. This transaction will result in Tritel, Inc. becoming a wholly-owned subsidiary of TPI. Also pending are Tritel requests for temporary and permanent 214 authority to provide international services. Thus, the need for Tritel and TPI to seek the Commission's consent to the transfer of any Section 214 authorization that may be granted to Tritel.

Grant of Applicants' request for consent to the transfer of any Section 214 authorization which Tritel may receive will further the public interest, convenience and necessity. It will permit TPI to enter into the United States international services market, and, thus, will promote

competition, lower prices for international services and permit more efficient use of existing international telecommunications facilities.

TPI requests to be classified as a non-dominant. It is entitled to a presumption of non-dominance on all routes under Section 63.10(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.10(a)(1). It has no affiliation with a foreign carrier, and is not itself a foreign carrier, operating in any international point.

For the foregoing reasons, Applicants request that the Commission permit the transfer from Tritel to TPI of any global blanket Section 214 authorization to provide resale switched, interconnected private line, and non-interconnected private line services between the United States and all international points as a non-dominant carrier granted to Tritel .
