Dear Ms. Salas:

Equant U.S., Inc. ("Equant U.S.") and Atlas Telecommunications S.A. ("Atlas"), by their counsel, hereby clarify that subsequent to the transaction in the above-captioned proceeding, Equant U.S. agrees, and has agreed, to provide service solely through the resale of an unaffiliated U.S. facilities-based carrier's international switched services (either directly or indirectly through the resale of another U.S. resale carrier's international switched services) on the routes between the U.S. and the Central African Republic, Chad, Côte d'Ivoire, Djibouti, El Salvador, French Guiana, French Polynesia, Guadeloupe, Madagascar, Martinique, Mayotte, Reunion Island, New Caledonia, Saint Pierre and Miquelon, Senegal, and Wallis and Futuna. Accordingly, Equant U.S. will provide service on these routes on the same basis as GlobalOne's current authorization.¹ This clarification applies to statements made at pages 3, 9 and 10 of the Application in the above-captioned proceeding.
