

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Impsat USA, Inc. ("Impsat USA"), through its attorneys and pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended 47 U.S.C. 5 214 (the "Act"), and Section 63.24 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. 0 63.24, hereby notifies the Commission that control of Impsat USA, which holds three international authorizations under Section 214 of the Act, has been transferred on a *pro forma* basis from its parent company, Impsat Fiber Networks, Inc. ("Impsat Fiber Networks"), to Impsat Fiber Networks as Debtor-in-Possession. This change in status reflects Impsat Fiber Networks' filing of a voluntary petition for reorganization in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York. See *In re Impsat Fiber Networks*, Case No. 02-12882 (R.E.G.) (Bankr.S.D.N.Y), filed June 11,2002.
