Dear Secretary Dortch:

Cebridge Telecom Limited, LLC, Cebridge Telecom General, LLC (together, "Cebridge" or "Transferees"), and multiple Cox entities (collectively with Cebridge "Applicants") filed the above-captioned joint international and domestic Section 214 application on December 16, 2005 ("Application").¹ In that Application, the parties identified communities in which schools and libraries customers receive telecommunications services and funding for such services from the federal Schools and Libraries program ("e-rate") that are to be transferred to Cebridge. See second and third pages of Attachment 3. It has come to the attention of the parties that certain of these communities are no longer Cox customers, or are receiving only Internet access services (not telecommunications services). 
