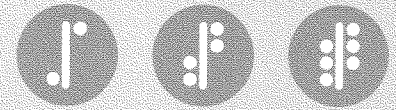
Dear Ms. Mukhoty:

By this letter, Latin Node, Inc. ("Latin Node") hereby amends its Notification of Pro Forma Transfer of Control ("Notification"), filed July 13, 2006, to address a request for additional information by the International Bureau staff.<sup>1</sup>

Retail Americas VoIP LLC ("Retail Americas") is the transferee in the transaction described in Latin Node's Notification, filed July 13, 2006. Retail Americas was formed to implement the transaction described in the Notification. In particular, Retail Americas was created to purchase Latin Node shares owned by two transferors (Giganet, S.A. and Rovicom, LLC) and to hold all of Latin Node's shares. The purpose of the transaction was to consolidate all of Latin Node's investors by purchasing the shares owned by financial investors and establishing one direct owner (Retail Americas) for all of Latin Node's shares. Currently, all shareholders of Latin Node prior to the transaction described in the Notification (other than the two shareholders who are identified as the transferors) indirectly own shares of Latin Node through Retail Americas. Retail Americas, in turn, remains the sole shareholder of Latin Node.

<sup>1</sup> Latin Node filed an application for Section 214 authority on February 26, 2004. In that application, Latin Node noted that there were three shareholders that controlled ten percent or more of Latin Node: Jorge Granados, Gloria Vasquez, and Olivia de la Salas. Upon review of Latin Node's corporate records, we have determined that as of February 26, 2004, there were only two shareholders who controlled ten percent or more of Latin Node: Mr. Granados owned 19.5 percent and Ms. de la Salas owned 19.5 percent. As of 2004, Ms. Vasquez owned 2 percent of Latin Node's shares. Currently Ms. Vasquez holds 9 percent of Aries shares which indirectly equate to approximately 3.5 percent of Latin Node's equity held through Retail Americas. Latin Node will correct this information contained in the original Section 214 application.



By this letter, Latin Node amends the information about the transferee provided in Attachment 1 to its Notification, Answer to Question 10, as follows: Retail Americas is owned 39.0908 percent by Aries International Holdings LLC (“Aries”) and 35.4545 percent by Richfield, Inc. (“Richfield”) Please note that the percentage ownership by Aries and Richfield were inadvertently transposed.

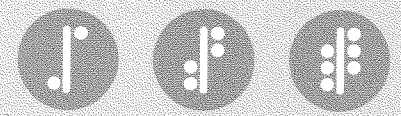
Latin Node also provides information, required by Section 63.18(h) of the Commission’s Rules, for each shareholder owning 10 percent or more of the equity in Retail Americas.

Juan Pablo Vasquez owns 14 percent; Mr. Vasquez is a United States citizen.

Gloria Vasquez owns 9 percent; Ms. Vasquez is a United States citizen (which equal indirectly approximately 3.5% of LatinNode).

Finally, the pro forma transaction was consummated on June 14, 2006. Please let me know if you require any further information.
