APPLICATION

Faith Communications, Inc ("FC") hereby requests pursuant to Sections

1.10016 and 63.25 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.10016, 63.25, special

temporary authority from the Commission for a transfer of control of Faith from Faith

Inc., a Japanese corporation ("Faith"), to Mr. Nakanishi, with regard to FC's international

global resale Section 214 authority, File Nos. ITC-214-20050811-00314 and ITC-TC-

20050913-00368. As described below, the transfer of control has been consummated. At

the time of the transaction, a failure to communicate resulted in the applicants

inadvertently failing to seek prior Commission approval of the transfer. Mr. Nakanishi is

working closely with FC and with counsel to ensure that corrective actions are taken to

prevent future unauthorized transfers of control. The applicants are simultaneously

seeking ~~Commission authorization, nunc pro tunc, of the transfer of control.~~ In the

interim, the applicants are hereby seeking Special Temporary Authority to prevent any

disruption of service to customers.

IP Telecom Group, Inc.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 50% owned by a citizen of Venezuela.

Application for consent to transfer control of all of the licenses and authorizations held by ARINC Inc. and its subsidiary Aeronautical Radio, Inc. to Carlyle Partners IV Telecommunications, L.P. (Carlyle Partners IV). Carlyle Partners IV will hold approximately 96% of the voting securities of ARINC. The indirect participation in ARINC by the **non-US limited partners** of Carlyle Partners IV will be approximately 35.8% in the aggregate, and these ownership interests will be widely dispersed. The largest equity interest in ARINC held by a non-US limited partner will be approximately 6.37%.
