CONSOLIDATED APPLICATION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF BIRCH TELECOM, INC.

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), and Sections 63.03, 63.04 and 63.24 of the Commission's Rules, Birch Telecom, Inc. ("Birch" or "Transferor"), along with Access Integrated Networks, Inc. ("AIN" or "Transferee") (together "Applicants"), hereby seek authority to transfer control of Birch, which holds certain domestic and international Section 214 authorizations both directly and indirectly, to AIN. The Applicants have entered into a purchase agreement by which AIN will purchase 100% of Birch's equity. As a result of the transfer, Birch will be a wholly-owned subsidiary of AIN.

In Section IV of this application, the Applicants provide the information required by Sections 63.18 and 63.24 of the Commission's Rules for transfer of control. As specified by Section 63.04(b) of the Commission's Rules, the additional information required for the transfer of the domestic authorizations is provided in Section V.

Applicants respectfully request streamlined treatment of this Application pursuant to Sections 63.03 and 63.12 of the Commission's Rules. As will be shown below, both the domestic and international components of this application qualify for streamlined processing.

I. DESCRIPTION OF THE APPLICANTS

A. Transferor (FRN: 0014685887, Birch Telecom, Inc.)

Transferor is a Delaware corporation headquartered in Kansas City, Missouri, that through its twenty-eight direct and indirect subsidiaries, provides voice and data services to small and medium-sized business customers in twenty-six states. All Birch subsidiaries are located at Transferor's address in Kansas City, Missouri.

B. Transferee (FRN: 0005044375, Access Integrated Networks, Inc.)

Transferee, a privately-held Georgia company headquartered in Macon, Georgia, provides local and long distance services to residential and small business customers in nine states.

II. DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSACTION

On November 1, 2007, Applicants entered into a purchase agreement ("Agreement") whereby AIN proposes to purchase all ownership interests in Birch in return for a cash payment. AIN is 100% owner of Access Merger which was organized for the purpose of merging with and into Birch. When the Transfer is consummated, Access Merger will merge out of existence and Birch will survive as a wholly owned subsidiary of AIN. Birch will continue to hold 100% of the equity, directly or indirectly, of each of its subsidiaries, with no change. In addition, no change in management or corporate structure is contemplated in the foreseeable future. The post-transaction corporate structure is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

III. PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT

The transfer of control to AIN will serve the public interest. AIN's experience and success in the local and long distance residential and business services markets make it particularly well-qualified to expand its operations as contemplated by its acquisition of Birch. The Transfer will be transparent to the Birch companies' customers and will not have an adverse effect on them. Customers will continue to enjoy the same services, rates, and quality that the Birch companies currently provide.

The Applicants expect that the result of this Transaction will increase competitive choice for consumers by bringing together companies that possess singular experience and strategic vision in their respective regional U.S. markets. The local and interexchange residential and business markets are highly competitive, and numerous independent providers including AIN and Birch, compete against larger

ILECs and RBOCs. In this respect, AIN's acquisition of and partnering with Birch will increase the ability of both companies to provide meaningful competition against larger providers through greater efficiencies and economies of scale. This increased competitive power in turn will give rise to better prices, higher service quality, and increased innovation.

(h) Ten Percent or Greater Interest Holders:

AIN is wholly owned by Access Investors, LLC, a venture capital enterprise, which in turn is owned by Holcombe Green (62%) and R. Kirby Godsey (33%), both United States citizens, and who each may be reached at One Buckhead Plaza, 3060 Peachtree St, NW, Suite 1060, Atlanta, GA 30305. No other person or entity owns a ten percent (10%) or greater direct or indirect ownership in AIN. No officer or director of AIN will also be an officer or director of any foreign carrier. The ten percent (10%) or greater direct or indirect owners of AIN do not hold any interest in telecommunications related entities that are not part of this transaction.

(i) Foreign Carrier Affiliation:

AIN certifies that it is not affiliated with any foreign carrier.

(j) Foreign Carrier and Destination Countries:

AIN certifies that it does not seek to provide international telecommunications service to any destination where: (1) AIN is a foreign carrier in that country; (2) AIN controls a foreign carrier in that country; (3) any entity that owns more than a 25% interest in AIN, or controls AIN, controls a foreign carrier in that country; or (4) two or more parties own, in the aggregate, more than 25% of AIN and are parties to, or the beneficiaries of, a contractual relationship that affects the provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.

(k) Showing of WTO Membership for Destination Countries:

Not applicable; AIN is not affiliated or otherwise related to any foreign carrier on any international route for which AIN provides service.

(l), (m) Showing of Non-Dominance/Regulatory Classifications:

Not applicable; AIN is not affiliated or otherwise related to any foreign carrier on any international route which AIN provides service.

(n) <u>Concessions</u>:

AIN certifies that it has not agreed and will not agree in the future to accept any direct or indirect special concessions from a foreign carrier or administration with regards to traffic or revenue flows between the United States and any foreign countries the company is authorized to serve.

(o) Federal Benefits:

AIN certifies pursuant to Sections 1.2001 through 1.2003 that no party to the application is subject to a denial of Federal Benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988. See 21 U.S.C. § 862.

(p) <u>Streamlined Processing</u>:

This application is entitled to streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules because the information provided herein clearly demonstrates: (1) AIN is not affiliated with a foreign carrier on any route for which authority is sought; (2) AIN is not affiliated with any dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private lines services it seeks to resell; and (3) AIN is not requesting authority to provide switched service over private lines to countries not previously authorized for service by the Commission.

V. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION § 63.04 OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES

Pursuant to Section 63.04(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.04(b), the Applicants submit the following additional information in support of their application to transfer control under Section 214 of the Act, as attached hereto as Exhibit C.

For these reasons, the grant of this Application is consistent with the public interest and Applicants respectfully request that the Commission grant this Application as expeditiously as possible through its streamlined procedures.



Access Integrated Networks, Inc. – Birch Telecom, Inc. Post Transaction Corporate Organization


