Trinity (and Caribbean Crossing) cannot satisfy the requirements of (k) because the Bahamas is non-WTO and Trinity's (and Caribbean Crossing's) foreign carrier affiliate is a The operative rules are Sec. 63.18(j)(3) and (k).
