By their attorney, Caribbean Crossings Ltd. ("CCL") and Trinity Communications Ltd. ("Trinity") hereby seek leave to supplement the public interest showing in the above-captioned applications to advise the Commission of telecommunications offerings which CCL and its parent, Cable Bahamas Ltd. ("CBL") provides to U.S. Government agencies in the Commonwealth of the Bahamas. Specifically, at present CCL provides one (1) DS3 data circuit to the U.S. Embassy in Nassau Bahamas and two (2) T1 data circuits to the Atlantic Undersea and Evaluation Center ("AUTECH") Naval Base of the U.S. Navy in Andros, Bahamas. In addition, CBL currently provides broadband services to U.S. Customs and Border Patrol in Nassau, Bahamas and the US Air Station – USCG in Inagua. CCL and Trinity respectfully submit that the public interest would be served by the continued availability of these offerings and should be considered in the Commission's evaluation of the above-captioned applications for transfer of control.
