I write to confirm information I left on your voice mail yesterday in response to your inquiry that was relayed to me by Corr Wireless' attorney, Don Evans.

I am the attorney for Cellular South Licenses, Inc. ("Transferee") in connection with the application for transfer of control of international Section 214 authorization held by Corr Wireless Communications, LLC. As indicated in the application, the controlling company of Transferee is Telapex, Inc. The "Answer to Question 11" of the application lists all of the stockholders of Telapex, Inc. ("Telapex") who own at least 10% of the stock of Telapex.

Trustmark National Bank is not a stockholder of Telapex. The Trustmark National Bank Trust Department is the sole trustee of the Telapex, Inc. Employee Stock Ownership Plan that owns 16.97% of Telapex stock.
