**SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION**

On November 2, 2009, Global Telecom & Technology, Inc. (“GTT”) and WBS Connect, L.L.C. (“WBS” and together with GTT, “Applicants”) filed an application requesting authority to consummate a transaction resulting in the transfer of ultimate control of WBS to GTT (the “Application”). The Commission assigned the Application the above-referenced docket number. Pursuant to Staff request, the Applicants hereby clarify and supplement their Application with the following:

(1) The Applicants clarify that WBS provides a suite of high bandwidth IP-based information and communications network services for a wide range of customers (carriers, ISPs, end users and others) on a nationwide basis. Although most of its services are not regulated, WBS offers an IP transport service which sometimes positions it to provide private line connections between customers and ISPs or between data centers as a

telecommunications service. These services are delivered utilizing IP technology over WBS' own Layer 2 VPN network.

(2) The Applicants confirm that other than the two (2) persons or entities listed in subsection (h) of Section IV on pp. 8-9 of the Application (i.e., Universal/Mr. Thompson and Mr. Cannell), there are no other persons or entities that hold 10% or more of the outstanding equity interests of GTT.

(3) In subsection (h) of Section IV, third line from the bottom in item (2), on p. 9 of the Application, "GCC" should read "GTT." Applicants apologize for this inadvertent typographical error.

(4) In subsection (h) of Section IV, item (2), on p. 9 of the Application, the Applicants supplement the Application with the following information: Anegada is a fund created under the laws of California; Tonga is a limited partnership formed under the laws of California; and Tonga QP is a limited partnership formed under the laws of California. The Funds are located at 240 West Deloney Avenue, P.O. Box 3459, Jackson, Wyoming 83001 and their principal business is investment. Cannell Capital LLC, a limited liability company formed under the laws of California, also has a principal business of investment and is located at 240 West Deloney Avenue, P.O. Box 3459, Jackson, Wyoming 83001.

The Applicants respectfully submit that the public interest, convenience, and necessity would be furthered by grant of this Application.
