PRO FORMA TRANSFER OF CONTROL OF
INTERNATIONAL SECTION 214 AUTHORITY

Answer to Question 10

Transferor Information (Intelsat Global, Ltd. (Bermuda)):

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with a copy to counsel:

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Section 63.18(d). Intelsat Global, Ltd. (Bermuda) does not hold any international Section 214 authorizations.

Transferee Information (Intelsat Global, S.A. (Luxembourg)):

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Section 63.18(d). Intelsat Global, S.A. (Luxembourg) does not hold any international Section 214 authority, but does indirectly control Intelsat General Corporation, which holds the international Section 214 authorization that is the subject of this notification: ITC-MOD-2005032900170 (global facilities-based service or global resale service).

Answer to Question 11

The proposed transactions constitute non-substantial (*pro forma*) transfers of control, because ultimate ownership and control of both the transferor and transferee and indirectly of the Section 214 holder, Intelsat General Corporation, will be exactly the same before and after the proposed transactions. The Commission has previously approved each person or entity that directly or indirectly controls at least ten percent of the equity of the transferee, Intelsat Global, S.A. (Luxembourg), in the *Intelsat-Serafina Order*.¹ There have been no material changes to the this ultimate ownership and control since the date of the *Intelsat-Serafina Order*.

Answer to Question 13

Intelsat hereby notifies the Commission of the *pro forma* transfer of control of the international section 214 authority held by Intelsat General Corporation from Intelsat Global, Ltd. (Bermuda) to Intelsat Global, S.A. (Luxembourg). As depicted in Exhibit 1, Intelsat General Corporation was owned and controlled through various directly and indirectly wholly-owned subsidiaries of Intelsat Global, Ltd., a Bermuda entity. These subsidiaries include the following Bermuda entities, each of which is an indirect parent of Intelsat General Corporation: Intelsat Global Subsidiary, Ltd.; Intelsat Holdings, Ltd.; Intelsat, Ltd.; Intelsat (Bermuda), Ltd.; Intelsat Jackson Holdings, Ltd.; Intelsat Intermediate Holding Company, Ltd. and Intelsat Subsidiary Holding Company, Ltd. (together with Intelsat Global, Ltd., the “Bermuda Entities”). Each of these Bermuda Entities was migrated to and reorganized as a Luxembourg entity, becoming respectively: Intelsat Global, S.A.; Intelsat Global Subsidiary, S.A.; Intelsat Holdings, S.A.; Intelsat, S.A.; Intelsat (Luxembourg), S.A.; Intelsat Jackson Holdings, S.A.; Intelsat Intermediate Holding Company, S.A. and Intelsat Subsidiary Holding Company, S.A. (collectively, the “Luxembourg Entities”). In connection with this migration, Intelsat (Bermuda), Ltd. changed its name to Intelsat (Luxembourg), S.A. The migration of the Bermuda Entities effected a *pro forma* transfer of control of the international Section 214 authority held by Intelsat General Corporation. The migration did not affect the assets held by Intelsat General Corporation or its ultimate ownership and control. It was merely a change in corporate form and jurisdiction of organization. The post-consummation holding structure for Intelsat General Corporation is illustrated in Exhibit 2.

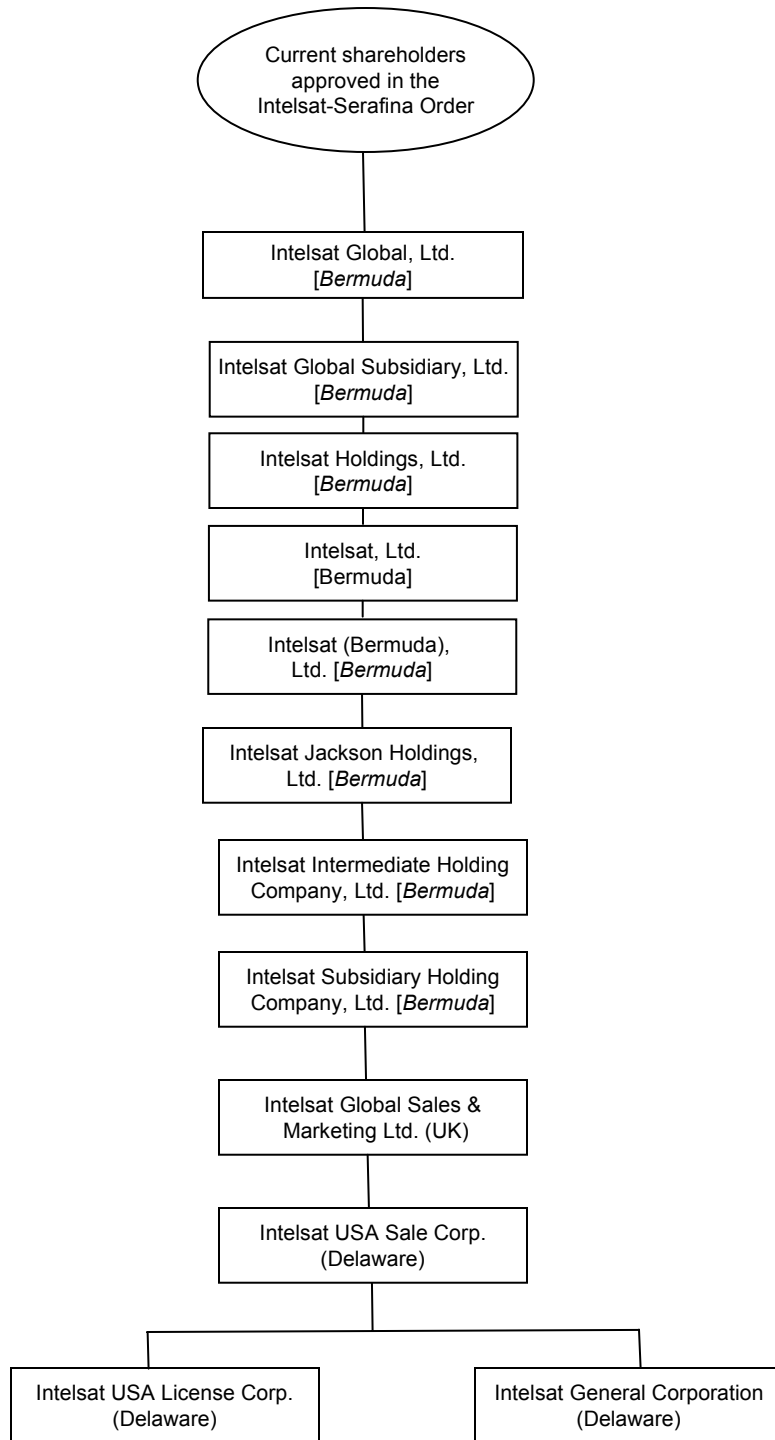
