Answers to Questions 10, 11, 12 and 13

CL TEL Long Distance, Inc. ("CL") and its parent company Clear Lake Independent Telephone Company ("Clear Lake") may have been subject to an involuntary and *pro forma* transfer of control on June 12, 2008 due to the death of Marcia A. Connell. If that was the case, such transfer of control would have affected the International Section 214 Authorization for Global Resale held by CL (File No. ITC-214-19961106-00558). CL and Clear Lake are both small Connell family-owned and operated corporations that were focused at the time upon the loss of Mrs. Connell, and did not realize that her death may have triggered an involuntary transfer of control that needed to be reported to the Commission. This situation was exacerbated by the fact that the parent company Clear Lake was controlled by Connell family trusts before and after Mrs. Connell's death, and that the relevant transfer of control was comprised of the replacement of Mrs. Connell by her daughter Janet A. Connell-Lovell as the trustee of one of the trusts.

Marcia A. Connell was the mother of Janet A. Connell-Lovell and Sarah J. Ohlrogge. Janet A. Connell-Lovell and Sarah J. Ohlrogge are sisters.

At the time of Marcia A. Connell's death, the Clear Lake shares held by the Marcia A. Connell 2005 Irrevocable Annuity Trust were transferred into the Marcia A. Connell Revocable Trust, or distributed to family members.

Subsequent to Marcia A. Connell's death, some of the Clear Lake shares held by the Marcia A. Connell Revocable Trust have been redeemed by the company or distributed to family members.

Answer to Question 12

Neither CL nor Clear Lake nor any of their subsidiaries or affiliates has any interlocking directorates with a foreign carrier.

Answer to Question 13

The subject involuntary and *pro forma* transfer of control consisted of the succession of Janet A. Connell-Lovell as Trustee of the Marcia A. Connell Revocable Trust upon her mother's death. This succession was automatic pursuant to the provisions of the trust documents. Prior to Marcia A. Connell's death, she controlled as Trustee of the Marcia A. Connell Revocable Trust and the Marcia A. Connell 2005 Irrevocable Annuity Trust the voting of 49.89 percent of Clear Lake's stock, while Janet A. Connell-Lovell controlled as Trustee of the Janet A. Connell-Lovell Revocable Trust the voting of 24.16 percent of Clear Lake's stock. After the death of Marcia A. Connell, Janet A. Connell-Lovell controlled as Trustee of the Marcia A. Connell Revocable Trust and the Janet A. Connell-Lovell Revocable Trust the voting of 68.62 percent of Clear Lake's stock. Presently, Janet A. Connell-Lovell continues as the Trustee of both trusts, and controls the voting of 61.34 percent of Clear Lake's stock. Throughout the period prior to and subsequent to Marcia A. Connell's death, Thomas Lovell, the husband of Janet A. Connell-Lovell has been the Vice President and day-to-day General Manager of Clear Lake and CL.
