On July 14, 2010, Telmex Holdings, Inc. ("Telmex Holdings") notified the Commission of the *pro forma* transfer of control of Telmex Holdings from Carso Global Telecom, S.A.B. de C.V. to América Móvil, S.A.B. de C.V. Telmex Holdings hereby clarifies its dominant carrier status for the record. Specifically, Telmex Holdings reaffirms its prior acceptance of dominant carrier regulation, under the Commission's rules, on the routes between the U.S. and each of Mexico, Guatemala, Nicaragua, El Salvador, Brazil and the Dominican Republic, without prejudice to seeking reclassification at a later date.
