On July 14, 2010, Telmex USA, L.L.C. ("Telmex USA") notified the Commission of the *pro forma* transfer of control of Telmex USA from Carso Global Telecom, S.A.B. de C.V. to América Móvil, S.A.B. de C.V. Telmex USA hereby clarifies its dominant carrier status for the record. Specifically, Telmex USA reaffirms its prior acceptance of dominant carrier regulation, under the Commission's rules, on the routes between the U.S. and each of Mexico, Guatemala, Nicaragua, El Salvador, Brazil and the Dominican Republic, without prejudice to seeking reclassification at a later date.
