Pursuant to sections 63.24(e) of the Commission’s rules, § 47 C.F.R 63.24(e), LatinTalk, LLC (“LATINTALK”) respectfully requests Commission consent for a substantial transfer of control of regarding its section 214 authorization, File No. ITC-20100622-002262. LATINTALK seeks to transfer a 50% interest to LATINO COMMUNICATIONS CORP.

**Description of the Proposed Transaction**

LATINTALK, LLC (“LATINTALK” or “Transferor”) wishes to transfer 50% of its membership interests to LATINO COMMUNICATIONS CORP (“LATINO” or “Transferee”). According to Section 63.24(e) of the Commission’s rules, § 47 C.F.R 63.24(e), *“In the case of ... transfer of control of an international section 214 authorization that is not pro forma, the proposed ... transferee must apply to the Commission for authority prior to consummation of the proposed ... transfer of control.”* This is considered a transfer of control since *“a change from 50 percent or more ownership to less than 50 percent ownership shall always be considered a transfer of control.”* Section 63.24(c) of the Commission rules. LATINTALK requests

Commission consent to continue to operate under Section 214 international file No. ITC-20100622-002262 after consummation of the transaction.

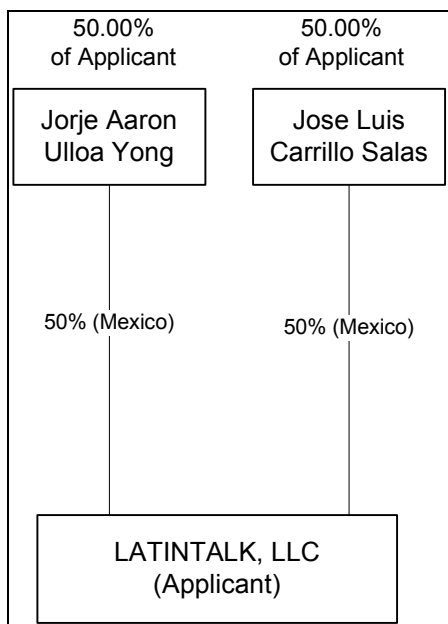


Figure 1. Ownership structure before transfer

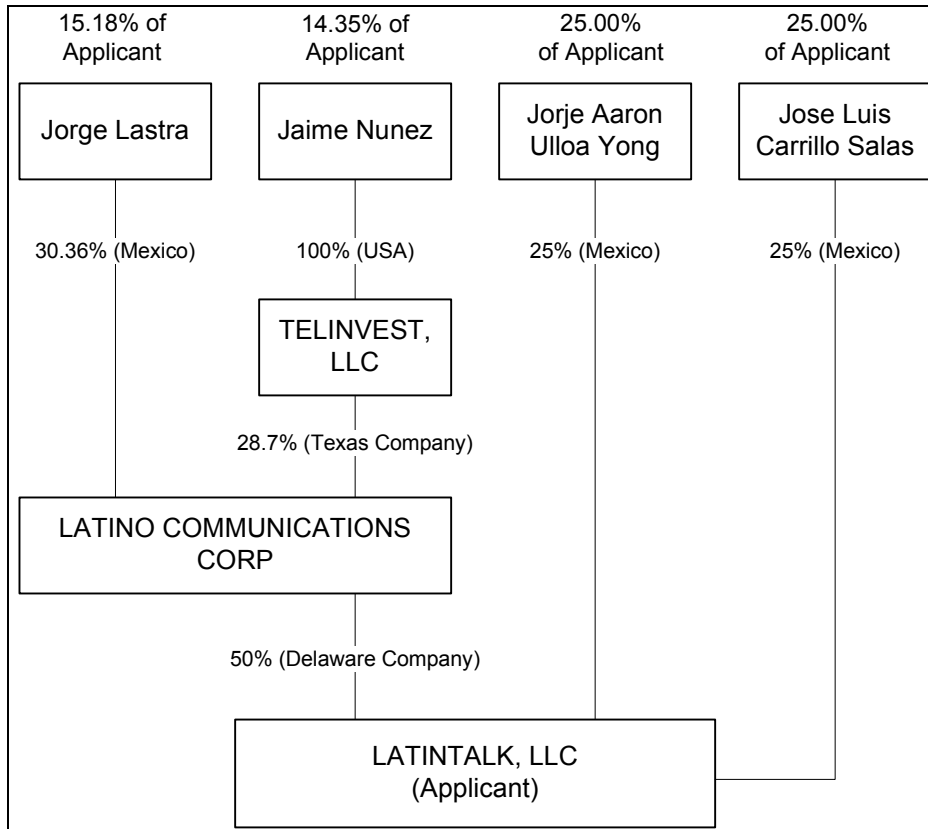


Figure 2. Ownership structure after proposed transfer of control
