Re: Withdrawal of Notice of Pro Forma Transfer of Control, File No. ITC-T/C-20120103-00001

Dear Ms. Dortch:

With this letter, Verscom, LLC (“Verscom”) respectfully requests to withdraw the notice of *pro forma* transfer of control of its International Section 214 Authorization^{1/} that Verscom filed with the International Bureau on January 3, 2012, which was assigned File No. ITC-T/C-20120103-00001. This withdrawal request is on advice of International Bureau staff, who have advised that the notice of *pro forma* transfer of control should be withdrawn and a full application for transfer of control should be submitted.

This letter also clarifies footnote 1 of the attachment to the notice of *pro forma* transfer of control. Verscom does not, in fact, provide any domestic telecommunications services and does not therefore hold any Domestic Section 214 Authorization that requires transfer. Consequently, subsequent to withdrawal of its notice of *pro forma* transfer of control, Verscom will be submitting an application for transfer of control only of its International Section 214 Authorization.
