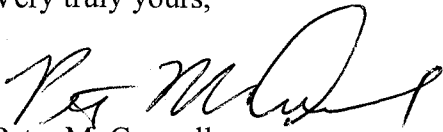

Supplement

The above-referenced application is hereby supplemented with the following information regarding the Nox Trust, which owns Global Secure Networks, Inc. ("GSN"), the Transferee.

In the application it is stated that the non-corporate individual trustee is Peter Slater, a U.S. citizen who resides in Scarsdale, New York. This will advise the FCC that Mr. Slater has resigned and three new trustees have been appointed as his successors. The three, all U.S. citizens, are Kevin J. Lederer, William G. Wade, and Guy M. Adams.

Mr. Lederer resides in Fairfield, CT. He currently serves as the Senior Vice President of Oxford Risk Associates, located in Melville, New York. He is a graduate of the Harvard Business School and has previously worked at the UK office of Bain and Company and in several entrepreneurial ventures, including a software business and printing company.

Mr. Wade resides in Palestine, Texas. He is retired and was previously involved in highway traffic management and glass bead manufacturing. He retired in April 2012 as Vice President at Weissker Manufacturing in Palestine, Texas.

Mr. Adams resides in Plano, Texas. He has been in aircraft sales and management for nearly 40 years. He started Global Jet Aviation LLC, an aviation consulting firm, in 1988 and currently serves as its Principal.

This will also advise the FCC that Reiner Mario Lemme, the grantor of the Nox Trust, has the power under the Trust to nominate successor individual trustees in the event a trustee resigns, dies, or becomes incapacitated. As previously noted in the application, individual trustees can only be removed for cause, and only by the protector of the Trust. The Protector of the Trust, as noted in the application, is Ivan A. Sacks.
