Dear Ms. Dortch:

In response to an FCC staff request, Telanetix, Inc. (“Telanetix”), AccessLine Communications Corporation and HCP-TELA, LLC, (collectively the “Applicants”), through their undersigned counsel, provides the following additional information.

- 1) Organizational structure. AccessLine Communications Corporation is a wholly owned subsidiary of AccessLine Holdings, Inc., which is a wholly owned subsidiary of Telanetix, Inc. Telanetix, Inc. is a publicly traded corporation. This corporate structure was the same before and after the 2010 transaction.
- 2) The only member of HCP-TELA, LLC, EREF-TELA, LLC and CBG-TELA, LLC that has a greater than 10% indirect ownership interest in AccessLine Communication Corporation is EREF Private Equity, LLC, a Delaware limited liability corporation. MP Alpha Holdings LLP, a Delaware limited liability partnership, is the only member of EREF Private Equity, LLC that has a greater than 10% indirect ownership interest in Access Line Communication Corporation. All of the owners of MP Alpha Holdings LLP are individuals and are US citizens.
- 3) There are no 10% or greater direct or indirect owners of AccessLine Communications Corporation, other than those specifically identified herein, our letter filed February 13, 2013 in the above-referenced dockets and in the application.
