Answer to Question 12

Section 63.18(h): Does the assignee/transferee have any interlocking directorates with a foreign carrier?

Commission Rule 63.09(g)(1) defines “interlocking directorates” as “persons or entities who perform the duties of ‘officer or director’ in an authorized U.S. international carrier or an applicant for international Section 214 authorization who also performs such duties for any foreign carrier.” AMX USA Holding, S.A. de C.V., is not a U.S. international carrier; it is a holding company. Therefore, Question 12 is not applicable to it.

¹ Inmobiliaria Carso, S.A. de C.V., (a non-public holding company wholly owned by the Slim family and duly organized under Mexican laws) also owns shares of América Móvil that represent less than ten percent of the voting shares of América Móvil. In addition, Carlos Slim Helú and members of his family individually own shares of América Móvil, though none in his or her individual capacity owns more than ten percent of the voting shares of América Móvil. Collectively, members of the Slim family, the Slim family trust, and Inmobiliaria Carso hold 42.27% of the equity and 65.50% of the voting stock in América Móvil.

In addition, AT&T Inc. (“AT&T”) (formerly known as SBC International, Inc.), a widely and publicly held corporation incorporated under the laws of the state of Delaware, holds approximately 9.11% of the equity (approximately 24.5% of the voting stock) of América Móvil through AA shares. Based on beneficial ownership reports filed with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) on March 1, 2011, AT&T also owned approximately 752 million L shares. As of April 30, 2011, 38.7% of the outstanding L shares of América Móvil were represented by L Share ADSs, each representing the right to receive 20 L shares, and 99.3% of the L Share ADSs were held by registered holders with addresses in the United States. 33.7% of the A shares were held in the form of A Share ADSs, each representing the right to receive 20 A shares, and 99.5% of the A Share ADSs were held by registered holders with addresses in the United States.

Answer to Question 13

By this filing, TracFone Wireless, Inc. provides Federal Communications Commission with notice of a pro forma transfer of control. Prior to August 31, 2007, Sercotel, S.A. de C.V. (“Sercotel”) had a 98.74% ownership interest in TracFone. América Móvil, S.A.B. de C.V. (“América Móvil”) directly owns 100% of Sercotel. On August 31, 2007, TracFone Wireless, Inc. (which was then a Florida corporation), completed a corporate restructuring. Specifically, TracFone Wireless, Inc. (Florida corporation) transferred its assets to TracFone Wireless, Inc. (Delaware corporation) and then was converted to TracFone Wireless, LLC, a 98.2% owner of TracFone Wireless, Inc. (Delaware corporation). As a result, TracFone Wireless, LLC became a new intermediary holding company wholly-owned by Sercotel. TracFone Wireless, LLC was subsequently renamed AMX USA Holding, LLC and was converted to a Mexican corporation named AMX USA Holding, S.A. de C.V. At all times, América Móvil has been the ultimate owner of TracFone Wireless, Inc.
