Dear Mr. May:

We have received an application seeking Commission consent to the transfer of control of the AmeriCan-1 cable license (SCL-LIC-19980123-00002) held by Allstream Fiber US, Inc. from MTS Inc. to 8312168 Canada, Inc. (Transferee). Allstream Fiber is a licensee of the AmeriCan-1 cable, which is operated on a non-common carrier basis between the United States and Canada.

Transferee is a company organized under the laws of Canada and is headquartered in Canada. 8312168 Canada, Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of Accelero Capital Investments Holdings, S.a.r.l. (“Accelero Capital Investments”), a **Luxembourg** limited liability company. Accelero Capital Investments, in turn, is a wholly owned subsidiary of Accelero Capital Holdings, S.a.r.l. (“Accelero Capital Holdings”), also a **Luxembourg** limited liability company.

The above-referenced application has been filed pursuant to the provisions of the Cable Landing License Act, 47 U.S.C. §§ 34-39, section 1.767 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.767, and Executive Order No. 10530, § 5(a) (May 10, 1954), reprinted as amended in 3 U.S.C. § 301. **The applicants have certified that on June 6, 2013, they have served copies of the application to the Department of State, NTIA, and DOD as required by the Commission’s rules 47 C.F.R. § 1.767 (j).**

This letter begins the 30-day review process set out in the letter from the Under Secretary of State for Economic, Business, and Agricultural Affairs to the Chairman, Federal Communications Commission (dated Dec. 3, 2001).
