Dear Mr. Donchenko:

This letter concerns the application (TTC-T/C-20130816-00211) filed on August 8, 2013 by LIGA Telecom, Inc. for authority to transfer 100 percent of LIGA Telecom, Inc. from the former owner Mr. Dmytro Artemenko, to you, the current owner. Since the transfer for which authority is sought was completed on November 17, 2012 without obtaining prior Commission consent, LIGA Telecom, Inc. sought Special Temporary Authority (STA) to continue providing services pending Commission consideration of the application.¹ On September 18, 2013, the Commission granted the STA.

The LIGA Telecom Inc. application remains pending review by Executive Branch agencies.² The STA however, expired on March 18, 2014. Our records do not show that LIGA Telecom Inc. has sought an extension of its STA pending action on its application. LIGA Telecom, Inc. may not provide services without a Commission authorization. You will need to seek an STA to continue to provide service.

Failure to respond to this letter within 14 days will subject your application to dismissal without prejudice under Sections 1.748(a) and 63.51(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. 1.748(a) and 63.51(b).

We are writing to follow-up on our previous correspondence to you concerning the application (TTC-T/C-20130816-00211) of LIGA Telecom, Inc. (LIGA Telecom). In that May 6, 2014 letter (attached), we informed you that LIGA Telecom's special temporary authority (STA) grant expired on March 18, 2014, and that you were required, under FCC rules, to renew the STA to continue to provide international services pending Commission consideration of the application. We have not received either a request for a STA or a response to the letter.

We have been notified by the outside counsel that filed the application on behalf of LIGA Telecom, The CommLaw Group, that it no longer represents LIGA Telecom. Further, we are informed that The Compliance Group, which has filed LIGA Telecom's 499A and 43.61 FCC reports with the Commission, also no longer represents LIGA Telecom.

We are sending this letter via your New York registered agent, Business Filings Incorporated, to provide LIGA Telecom a final opportunity to respond to the May 6, 2014 letter prior to our action on LIGA Telecom's application. Please respond within 14 days from the date of this letter.
