RE: Application of Krush Communications, LLC and Agregato (USA) Inc. for Grant of Authority Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as Amended, and Sections 63.04 and 63.24 of the Commission's Rules to Complete an Assignment of Assets of an Authorized Domestic and International Section 214 Carrier; WC Dkt. Dear Ms. Dortch:

Krush Communications, LLC ("Krush") and Agregato (USA) Inc. ("Agregato USA") (collectively the "Applicants"), through undersigned counsel, hereby file a Supplement to the above-referenced application to assign the assets of Krush to Agregato USA, including "blanket" section 214 domestic authority and an International Section 214 authorization.¹

Applicants are filing this Supplement to respond to specific questions from International Bureau staff. Applicants' responses are below.

- 1) The application states that the transaction will have no adverse impact on Krush's existing customers. So who is currently providing them services? Is Agregato USA providing services since the September 1, 2013 consummation?

ANSWER: Since the consummation of the September 1, 2013 transaction ("Transaction"), the new owner, Agregato USA, has been conducting business through its subsidiary, Krush. All telecommunications services provided by Krush prior to the Transaction continued unchanged and uninterrupted following the Transaction. All of Krush's pre-existing contracts, policies and procedures have remained in place since the Transaction. Agregato USA also retained Krush's key

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personnel to manage the Company's day-to-day operations. As a result, the ownership transfer was unnoticeable to Krush's existing prepaid customers.

- 2) Did Krush become Agregato USA's subsidiary, cease to exist after closing, or is it now providing services pursuant to the international 214 authorization that was assigned to Agregato USA?

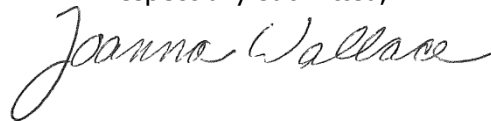
ANSWER: See Response to #1. Krush became Agregato USA's subsidiary and continues to provide telecommunications as it had prior to the Transaction in an unchanged, uninterrupted manner.

- 3) Please confirm that there are no 10% or greater ownership interests in M2 Telecommunications Group Ltd, a publicly held company, because there can be 10% or greater interests in a publicly held company.

ANSWER: Applicants confirm that there are no 10% or greater ownership interests in M2 Telecommunications Group, Ltd.
